

## 2009 NGWA Camp Sponsorship Program

### Frequently Asked Questions

Q. How much time, resources and manpower are required to present an NGWA sanctioned Goalie War tournament?

A. That depends on how many players will be competing. You simply advise the NGWA how many campers will be participating, how many sets of goals you have, how many staff members/referees will be available to officiate the games and how much time you would like to allocate to the tournament and the NGWA will schedule the tournament to accommodate your needs.

Q. What equipment would I have to provide?

A. Goals, nets, balls and cones, tape or lining equipment and paint

Q. What would the NGWA provide?

A. Tournament hosting manual, schedule, player towels, penalty flags, goal counter devises, award certificates.

Q. What information would I have to provide the NGWA before the tournament?

A. The date and times allocated for the tournament. The number of goals and soccer balls available. The number of staff members and/or referees available. The names, gender, DOB, address and email address of all players.

Q. What information would I have to provide the NGWA after the tournament?

A. You must return the score sheets via fax or email so that we can post the scores and announce the winners. You may keep the towels, flags and scoring devises for future events.

Q. Will the NGWA sell player information to any third party?

A. Absolutely not. We need that information to schedule the tournament and send the registration information, rule books, press releases and surveys to the players.

Q. Will the NGWA provide me with an exclusive market to present an NGWA sanctioned tournament?

A. It depends on the size of your market and the number of camp(s) and campers you have.

Q. How will you help advertise my camps?

A. Your company will be featured on our web site with direct links to your web site. We'll also add your camps to our calendar of events and send out monthly email blasts announcing your camp/training schedule.

Q. Can I advertise my company at your National Championship?

A. Yes, you'll have the opportunity to sponsor our national championship and gain additional exposure through on site signage, program ads, company booths, PA announcements, auction items, raffles and media coverage.

Q. Can I allow additional players to come in just for the tournament? If so, can I charge them a fee to play?

A. Yes, how much you charge them is up to you.

Q. Does my camp have to have general liability insurance?

A. Yes. The NGWA requires to be named as an additional insured on your policy.
